PRELIMINARY SUB-CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT

Preliminary Sub-contractor Agreement

This Preliminary Sub-Contractor Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into between:

Together referred to as the “Parties”.

1. PURPOSE

1.1 This Agreement sets out the preliminary terms under which the Sub-Contractor will provide services to Luoma on a project-by-project basis.

1.2 This Agreement does not guarantee the Sub-Contractor a specific volume of work. Each project engagement will be confirmed in writing via a separate Scope of Works and Purchase Order.

1.3 This Agreement remains in force for a period of 24 months from the date of execution, unless earlier terminated by either party in writing.

2. SCOPE OF WORKS

2.1 The scope of works for each engagement will be defined in a written Scope of Works document issued by Luoma prior to commencement.

2.2 No works shall commence without a signed Scope of Works and an issued Purchase Order.

2.3 Variations to the scope must be requested in writing and approved by Luoma prior to commencing the varied the works.

2.3A Approval Requirement

The subcontractor agrees that only an authorised Luoma representative can approve variations and works and no variation shall be valid unless:

- Submitted in writing
- Approved in writing by an authorised Luoma representative

Authorised representatives are:

- Luoma Building Supervisors
- Luoma Project Managers

Verbal discussions or site instructions are not approval.

2.3B Proceeding Without Approval

If the Contractor proceeds with variation works without written approval:

- The Contractor waives all rights to claim additional costs or time

2.3C Variation Pricing

All variations must be priced and agreed upon prior to commencement.

If pricing is not agreed:

- Luoma may direct works at reasonable market rates, or
- Decline the variation entirely

2.4 The Contractor shall perform all works and/or supply materials in accordance with:

- Issued drawings
- Specifications
- BOQs
- Schedules
- RFIs
- Written directions issued by Luoma

2.5 The Contractor acknowledges:

- It has fully reviewed all documentation prior to accepting the PO

It has allowed for all labour, materials, coordination, access, and works necessary to complete the scope

2.6 The contract sum includes all works:

- Reasonably inferable from the documentation
- Necessary for the proper completion of the works

No claim shall arise for:

- Omissions
- Ambiguities
- Misinterpretation

All trade coordination shall be carried out through the Luoma Building Supervisor.

2.7 All project-specific commercial terms, including pricing, payment, variations, program obligations, and risk allocation, are governed solely by the issued Purchase Order and Luoma Purchase Order Terms & Conditions. In the event of any inconsistency, the Purchase Order shall prevail.

3. PAYMENT TERMS

3.1 Progress claims must be submitted in accordance with the Building Industry Fairness (Security of Payment) Act 2017 (QLD) or the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act 1999 (NSW), as applicable.

3.2 Luoma will assess and process payment within 14 calendar days of receiving a valid invoice or progress claim.

3.3 Payment will be made by electronic funds transfer to the bank account nominated on the Sub-Contractor Registration Form.

3.4 Luoma reserves the right to withhold payment for works that do not meet the required standard until defects are rectified.

4. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Sub-Contractor must hold and maintain the following insurances throughout the term of any engagement and provide certificates of currency prior to commencement of works:

Public Liability Insurance	\$10,000,000.00	Commencement
Workers Compensation	As required by law	Commencement
Professional Indemnity (if applicable)	\$5,000,000.00	Commencement
Plant & Equipment (if applicable)	Replacement value	On-site use

5. LICENCE & REGISTRATIONS

5.1 The Sub-Contractor warrants that they hold all licenses and registrations required by law to carry out the works, including but not limited to a current QBCC Contractor License and/or NSW Fair Trading Contractor License as applicable.

5.2 Copies of all relevant licenses must be provided with this Agreement and updated immediately upon renewal.

5.3 The Sub-Contractor must notify Luoma immediately if any license or registration lapses, is suspended, or is canceled.

6. WHS OBLIGATIONS

6.1 The Sub-Contractor must comply with all applicable Work Health and Safety legislation, including the Work Health and Safety Act 2011 (QLD/NSW) and associated Regulations and Codes of Practice.

6.2 The Sub-Contractor must provide a current Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS) for all high-risk construction work prior to commencement.

6.3 All workers engaged by the Sub-Contractor must hold a current Construction Induction Card (White Card) and any trade-specific safety requirements.

6.4 The Sub-Contractor must comply with Louma Site Safety Induction requirements prior to commencing works on any Luoma site.

6.5 Luoma reserves the right to remove any worker from site who fails to comply with safety requirements.

7. QUALITY OF WORKS

7.1 All works must be completed in a proper and workmanlike manner, in accordance with the Scope of Works, approved drawings, and relevant Australian Standards and any approved QA documentation.

7.2 The Sub-Contractor is responsible for rectifying any defective or incomplete works at their own cost.

7.3 A defects liability period of 12 months applies from the date of practical completion of the Sub-Contractor's works unless specified otherwise or required under relevant scope.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

8.1 The Sub-Contractor must keep confidential all information relating to Luoma's clients, projects, pricing, methods, and business operations.

8.2 The Sub-Contractor must not make contact with Luoma's clients directly without prior written consent from Luoma.

9. CONDUCT & COMPLIANCE

9.1 The Sub-Contractor and their workers must conduct themselves professionally at all times on Luoma sites and when dealing with Luoma clients, consultants, and trades.

9.2 The Sub-Contractor must comply with all site rules, Luoma's delivery standards, and any reasonable direction given by Luoma's site management team.

10. TERMINATION

10.1 Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing 14 days' written notice.

10.2 Luoma may terminate this Agreement by providing a 24 hour notice for any individual project terminations.

10.3 Luoma may terminate this Agreement immediately and without notice if the Sub-Contractor breaches any material term of this Agreement, fails to comply with safety requirements, or has its licence or registration canceled.

10.4 Upon termination, the Sub-Contractor is entitled to payment for works satisfactorily completed up to the date of termination only.

11. GOVERNING LAW

11.1 This Agreement is governed by the laws of Queensland, Australia. In the event of a dispute, the parties agree to attempt to resolve the matter through good-faith negotiation before pursuing any formal dispute resolution process.
